Mount St Benedict College produced an excellent set of results in the Higher School Certificate.

Congratulations and well done to the students for their hard work, the parents for their support and the professionalism of the teachers.

Samantha Camilleri achieved the highest ATAR of 99.5, followed by Antonia Chacon 98.20 and Francesca Alexandra 97.65.

37 % of the eligible cohort achieved an ATAR of over 90. 67 % of students received an ATAR over 80. This year our 57 students achieved 157 Band 6's.
