HSC 2016 Results

Mount St Benedict College produced yet again, a very good set of results in the Higher School Certificate.

Congratulations and well done to the students for their hard work, the parents for their support and the professionalism of the teachers.

Congratulations to Samantha Hardman, Amy Maher and Nicole Zeaiter who received a mention on the All Rounder List. This list acknowledges students who achieved a Band 6 (or its equivalent) in ten of their HSC units, including English.

This year the College had 135 mentions on the Distinguished Achievers List. This list acknowledges students who achieved a Band 6 or its equivalent in the respective courses.

In 28 of the 34 courses attempted the mean examination mark for the College was higher than the State's mean and in 80% of these courses the mean was at least 5 marks higher than the State's mean.

It is estimated that 29% of the eligible cohort achieved an ATAR over 90, 58% achieved an ATAR over 80 and 83% achieved an ATAR over 70.
