The assessor can NOT be a parent or other relative. If your relative is the team's coach then ask the team manager or a club official;

All assessors need to complete the Volunteer Code of Conduct form attached unless your assessor is a teacher at MSB

Camps:

OEG, the company that run the Yr7 & 8 camps, also run Duke of Ed camps during the holidays. Attached is their information on camps dates and costs.

You must do two (2) camps in different locations and importantly they must be the same type of camp. You can change the mode for your next level of Award but not within the level:

Bronze camp1 & camp2 – hike or camp1 & camp 2 – paddle but you can't do camp1 – hike & camp 2 paddle.

When you come to do Silver you can choose a different mode of travel to your Bronze if you wish.
