## HSC 2013 Results

Mount St Benedict College produced an excellent set of results in the Higher School Certificate.

Congratulations and well done to the students for their hard work, the parents for their support and the professionalism of the teachers.

Samantha Saunders achieved the highest ATAR of 98.90 followed by Natalie Grima (98.55) and Selina Zeaiter (98.15). Congratulations to these girls for an excellent performance.

Of the 112 students eligible 36% received an ATAR over 90, 32% received an ATAR between 80 - 90 and 19% received an ATAR between 70-80.

Congratulations to Natalie Grima and Selina Zeaiter who received a mention on the All Rounder List. This list acknowledges students who achieved a Band 6 (or its equivalent) in ten of their HSC units [including English].

Congratulations to Gemma Morris and Josephine Princi for receiving a mention on the Top Achievers List (Top 10 place in the respective course). Gemma placed equal 8<sup>th</sup> in Food Technology and Josephine placed equal 9<sup>th</sup> for Hospitality.

This year the College had 134 mentions on the Distinguished Achievers List. This list acknowledges students who achieved a Band 6 or its equivalent in the respective courses.
