Other outstanding results

- The College performed at an outstanding level with:
 - Ancient History 18.52% above the State mean,
 - Food Technology 16.55% above the State mean,
 - Mathematics General 16.28% above the State mean,
 - Business Services 14.43% above the State mean and
 - Music 1 14.24% above the State mean
- 100% of MSB Students who studied Music 1 achieved a Band 6 compared to 18% across the State.
- 100% of MSB students who studied Ancient History, Business Services, Design and Technology, Entertainment Industry, Food Technology, Geography, Hospitality and Music 1 achieved a Band 5 or 6.
- In Ancient History, the combined Bands 5 and 6 compared to the State's aggregate was 65% higher than the State's mean and 60% of students achieved a Band 6 compared to 9% in the State
- In Business Services, the combined Band 5 and 6 results were 81% higher than the State's mean
- In Design and Technology, the combined Band 5 and 6 results were 63% higher than the State's mean
- In Entertainment Industry, the combined Band 5 and 6 results were 83% higher than the State's mean
- In Food Technology, the combined Band 5 and 6 results were 71% higher than the State's mean
- In Geography, the combined Band 5 and 6 results were 56% higher than the State's mean
- In Hospitality, the combined Band 5 and 6 results were 69% higher than the State's mean
- 86% of MSB students studying Personal Development, Health and Physical Education achieved a Band 5 or 6 compared to just 30% of all NSW students
- 82% of MSB students studying Mathematics General achieved a Band 5 or 6 compared to just 25% of all NSW students
