## NETBALL NSW PRIVACY POLICY

It is the policy of the NSW Netball Association Ltd to comply with the Privacy Act. Personal information about you is only obtained from information provided by you. This data is collected by NSW District Associations affiliated with Netball NSW. Member Information is collected for the following purposes:

### Statistics

Personal information in an aggregated format is collated to produce statistics that is supplied to government agencies as required. The information is used by Netball NSW for research, developing and managing new and existing programs, for strategic and planning purposes and for the promotion of netball in NSW. An individual's personal information is not identifiable or provided in this data.

### Administration & Information

Personal information may be used for communicating and providing information to participants about their membership and/or their involvement in programs, competitions, including those of sponsors and other general netball activities. Any member can request not to receive mail communications that do not directly relate to their participation in programs or their membership.

### Disclosure of Membership Information

Netball NSW may facilitate aggregate database access for Netball Australia, sponsors and other relevant interested parties to enable these bodies the opportunity to have mail outs forwarded to members. In such cases member's personal contact information is not provided. Third parties, such as mailing houses, may on the signing of a confidentiality agreement, obtain a copy of aggregate data.

### 'Opt In/Out'

Netball NSW provides all members the opportunity to 'opt in' of any direct communication with the organisation. Further to this members are provided with an 'opt out' clause at the time of communication. *Further information about the Netball NSW Membership Privacy Policy is available from your affiliated Association or alternatively from Netball NSW.*

## **MSB Netball Club: Player's Code of Conduct**

1. Play by the rules.
2. Never argue with an official. If you disagree, have your captain, coach or manager approach the official during a break or after the competition.
3. Control your temper. Verbal or Physical abuse of officials or other participants in the sport, deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent is not acceptable or permitted and you may be removed from the game by your coach if you choose to engage in this behaviour.
4. Work equally hard for yourself and your team. This includes attending and participating wholeheartedly in training sessions and being punctual and warming up before games (it is expected that players arrive half an hour before their allocated game time on a Saturday).
5. Be a good sport. Applaud all good plays whether they are by your team or the opposition.
6. Treat all players, as you would like to be treated. Do not interfere with, bully or take unfair advantage of another player.
7. Co-operate with your coach, teammates and opponents. Remember that your coach gives up their time and energy to plan, train and coach you. If you cannot make a training session or game it is common courtesy to let the coach themselves know as early as possible. If you miss a training session with no notification or reasonable excuse, you will miss out on court time (usually half a game).
8. Enjoy the sport in every possible way.
